

MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY'S REPORT FOR 2015

In 2015 we had 260 members of all types (detailed below) and 77 subscribers to the journal. Of these, 19 were new members (including 6 students (one overseas), 3 overseas members and two family memberships). There were 2 new institutional subscribers.

During 2015, we were notified that three members had died (including one life member), and 5 members, 2 students and 5 families resigned or cancelled their membership payments before 2016. One institutional subscriber has cancelled ahead of renewing for 2016.

As of 1 April 2016, 191 members of all types have already renewed their memberships (not including the 21 honorary and life members), as have 61 institutional subscribers; we have 7 new members in 2016, including one family, and one new institutional subscriber.
